4. Canskate is only coached by certified coaches.
5. Skaters will learn all the fundamentals of skating on a daily basis in Canskate. Stopping, turning, forwards, backwards, jumping, spinning.

Coaches Corner;

Starskate test Day;

Primary test list must be submitted to Skate Canada three weeks before the test day. A final list must be given two weeks prior to the test day. Envelopes will be handed out after this date. Please check with your skater or coach if you did not receive an envelope and your coach has told you that your skater will be taking a test. Skate Canada will then assign our club with an evaluator. This is not always an easy process as most evaluators have full time jobs and they do this as volunteer time because they love the sport. After this we can then post the schedule we do our best to have the schedule posted at least one week before the test day. All tests take place during the day. We try to start with high tests in the morning and work our way down during the day. Timing will depend on how many skaters are taking a test. It is imperative that you hand in your test envelope before the test date. If you should have any questions about test day you should see your private coach.
